We asked foreign residents in Japan



Roads in Japan are narrow. I saw convex mirrors at intersections for the first time after coming to Japan.

In 2019, intersections had the highest number of fatal traffic accidents in Japan (34.3% of all accidents).



For this reason, convex mirrors are installed at narrow, low-visibility intersections. Be sure to check for oncoming vehicles or other hazards in the mirror before proceeding. Also, note that the mirrors show left and right in reverse!
